- Argument for free will






202 AD Leonides, Origen's father, is martyred



WORLD ISN'T REAL


- No truth to be discovered within the world
- Truth is a mystical experience beyond this world


MATERIAL WORLD IS EVIL

- Sin is related to our physical bodies
- Body was of no consequence
- Two lifestyles:
 - Asceticism severe fasting from food and sex
 - Compartmentalization ritual orgies

SECRET KNOWLEDGE

- Salvation is through
 - secret knowledge that individuals come to know themselves
 - Christ the Redeemer, who frees the spirit from contamination of matter
- No mention of the cross








